## Polling Places

*(since 1996)*

Where you live determines where you vote in school elections. Qualified voters must be a US Citizen, at least 18 years old, and a resident of the school district for at least 30 days prior to the date of the vote. You need not be a registered voter.

4	Legislative Districts 12, 13, 14 and 15 and portions of Fleming within the Auburn School District- <b>Residents that voted at West Middle School will now vote at Seward Elementary School due to the sale of West Middle</b>	Seward Elementary

### **Absentee Ballots**

Qualified school district voters who are unable to vote in person on **Tuesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>** may vote by absentee ballot. To receive an absentee ballot, individuals must fill out an application for the ballot.
