1.0 CALL TO ORDER

MR. McCOLE CALLED THE PUBLIC FORUM TO ORDER AT 6:30 P.M. HE SPOKE TO THE PUBLIC REGARDING OUR UPCOMING BUDGET FOR 2017-2018. MR. McCOLE GAVE AN OVER-VIEW OF THE BUDGET AND HOW IT IS CALCULATED. HE WENT OVER THE TAX LEVY INFORMATION AND OPENED UP THE FLOOR TO THE PUBLIC. ANYONE FROM THE COMMUNITY WAS WELCOME TO COME UP TO THE LECTURN AND SPEAK FOR 3 MINUTES TO ADDRESS THE BOARD ON THE TOPIC OF THE TAX LEVY AND/OR THE SCHOOL BUDGET.

2.0 RESIDENTS HEARD

BRUCE DAMALT OF 19 HENRY DRIVE DISCUSSED PERSONNEL COSTS AND THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THESE COSTS DRASTICALLY REDUCED IN THE FUTURE. TEACHERS SHOULD NOT HAVE RAISES AND PAY RATES SHOULD BE CUT. THEY SHOULD GIVE BACK AND THERE SHOULD BE RULES AGAINST ANY POSSIBLE STRIKES.

DIA CARABAJAL SPOKE ABOUT THE 2% TAX CAP AND HOW INCONSISTENCY IN THIS CAP FROM YEAR TO YEAR CAUSES PROBLEMS FOR EVERYONE. THE BOUNCE FROM .12% ALL THE WAY UP TO 3.98% IS TOO MUCH OF A DRASTIC CHANGE FOR PEOPLE. HOWEVER, WE NEED THE FULL RESOURCES AVAILABLE FOR OUR KIDS.

DAN SOULES OF 48 LAKESHORE DRIVE DISCUSSED THE VAST DIFFERENCES BETWEEN TAX RATES IN NEW YORK VERSUS TAX RATES IN OTHER STATES, SUCH AS DOWN SOUTH. HE IS A BUSINESS OWNER IN 2 STATES AND COULD ATTEST TO THE DIFFICULTIES WITH THE HIGH NEW YORK TAX RATES.

JAMES CASASANTA OF 4765 WESTLAKE ROAD DISCUSSED THE FACT THAT HE DID NOT HAVE ANY SOLUTIONS FOR THIS BOARD BUT RAISING TAXES IS DIFFICULT. RAISING TAXES WOULD TAKE AWAY FROM WHAT LITTLE "DISCRETIONARY DOLLARS" PEOPLE HAVE TO SPEND. RAISING SCHOOL TAXES WOULD HELP TO FORCE OUT RESIDENTS AND CAUSE "SNOW BIRDS" TO CONSIDER STAYING IN SOUTHERN STATES YEAR ROUND. ALSO THE TURF MAY NOT HAVE BEEN A GOOD DECISION FOR AUBURN AS IN THE FUTURE, THE UPKEEP WILL ADD EXPENSES TO OUR DISTRICT THAT WE DON'T NEED.

KARA GEORGI OF 9 KEARNEY AVENUE WANTS THE BOARD TO TAKE A GOOD LOOK AT WHO WE ARE CUTTING AND THE LIVES THAT WOULD BE AFFECTED. SHE SUGGESTS WE START A "TWITTER STORM" AND TRY VERY HARD TO UNITE THE ENTIRE AUBURN COMMUNITY TO HELP GET OUR MESSAGE TO THE OFFICIALS IN ALBANY AND WASHINGTON. SHE DOESN'T THINK WE HAVE DONE ENOUGH TO GET THE WORD OUT TO THE PUBLIC ABOUT OUR FINANCIAL PROBLEMS COMING UP IN AUBURN.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Auburn, Cayuga County, New York, as follows:

Section 1: The annual election of members of the Board of Education shall be held in the City School District of the City of Auburn, Cayuga County, New York, on May 16, 2017, for the purpose of voting on candidates to fill three (3) full terms of

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three (3) years each, commencing on July 1, 2017 and expiring on June 30, 2020. The candidate receiving the largest number of votes, the candidate receiving the second highest number of votes, and the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes shall be entitled to a full three (3) year term on the Board of Education commencing on July 1, 2017 and expiring on June 30, 2020.

Section 2: The annual meeting for the purpose of voting upon a school district budget for the City School District of the City of Auburn, Cayuga County, New York, shall be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, at the same time and at the same places within the said School District as the annual election of members of the Board of Education of said School District.

Section 3: The polls for such annual election and budget vote shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., prevailing time, at the voting places designated by the Board of Education for each of the school election districts of the School District, which have been established by the Board of Education.

Section 4: The Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Auburn, Cayuga County, New York, shall hold a public hearing on May 9, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., prevailing time, in the Library Media Center, Auburn High School, 250 Lake Avenue, Auburn, New York 13021, at which time the Board of Education will present the budget to the voter.

Copies of the budget will be made available upon request to residents within the School District (not just District taxpayers) during the fourteen (14) days preceding the date of the annual meeting and election at each schoolhouse in the School District in which school is maintained, between the hours 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., prevailing time, on each day other than Saturday, Sunday or holidays.

Section 5. The Board of Registration of the School District, will meet at the Offices of the Board of Education, Harriet Tubman Administration Building, 78 Thornton Avenue, Auburn, New York 13021, on April 26, 2017, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., prevailing time, and on April 27, 2017, between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m., prevailing time, to prepare the school election district registers for the annual election and budget vote to be held in the School District on May 16, 2017.

Section 6. The annual meeting, annual election, budget hearing, and registration of voters, shall be called by giving the following notices:
